
INBOUNDING POSITIONS ON THE COURT

In basketball, an "inbounding position" refers to the spot on the sideline or baseline where a player stands to throw the ball back into play after it goes out of bounds; this spot is determined by where the ball last crossed the boundary line, and the inbounding player must stay behind that line while throwing the ball to a teammate on the court.
